Availability & Prices

All goods are offered for sale subject to availability. We regret that occasionally it may be impossible to complete an order if a product is withdrawn for any reason. The price of the goods shall be the price listed on our website. We reserve the right to amend prices in the event of a change in the rate of VAT or supplier costs. All prices and delivery charges are quoted in UK Pounds Sterling and must be paid in full at the time of ordering. In the exceptional circumstances that any particular item of clothing is not in stock we reserve the right to provide an alternative of the same colour and quality.

Registration

Users of the Lincolnshire Cricket Website may be required to register in order to use certain facilities.

Ordering

We will treat each order for goods as an offer by you to purchase the goods, subject to these terms and conditions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of your order and we shall supply you, subject to availability, with the quantity and specification of the goods set out in your order.

Payment

Payment may be made by any of the methods indicated on the site. We do not offer any credit facilities, so we will not deliver goods to you if you do not pay for your order in full at the time of ordering.

Our store is hosted on Shopify Inc. They provide us with the online e-commerce platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you.

Your data is stored through Shopify's data storage, databases and the general Shopify application. They store your data on a secure server behind a firewall.

If you choose a direct payment gateway to complete your purchase, then Shopify stores your credit card data. It is encrypted through the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI-DSS). Your purchase transaction data is stored only as long as is necessary to complete your purchase transaction. After that is complete, your purchase transaction information is deleted.
